KINSHIP FOSTERING

For generations, extended families have played significant roles in the rearing of children when parents are having a difficult time. This is known as kinship care or relative care, where the caregivers provide children the benefit of more stability of care when they can't live with their birth parents.



Benefits of Kinship:

- Provides love and care in a familiar setting.
- Provides Parents with a sense of hope that the children will remain connected to their birth family.
- Enables children to live with people they know and trust.
